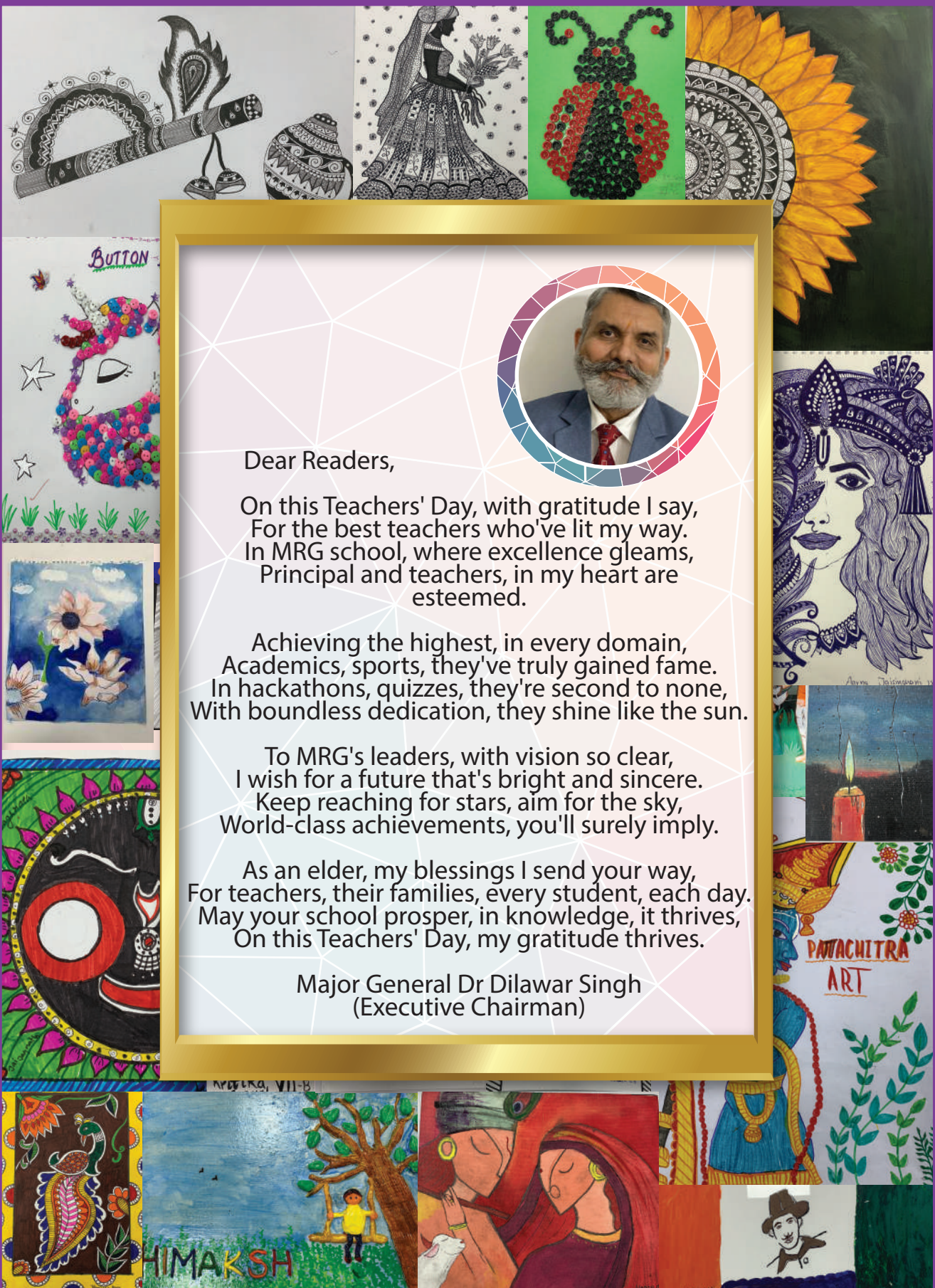

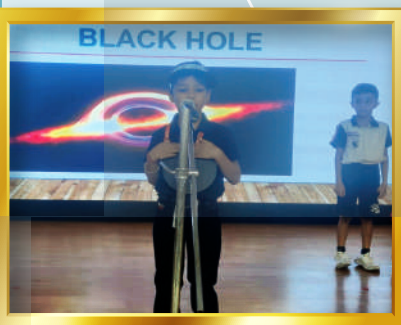

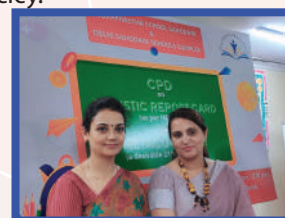


Capacity Building Programme for English
