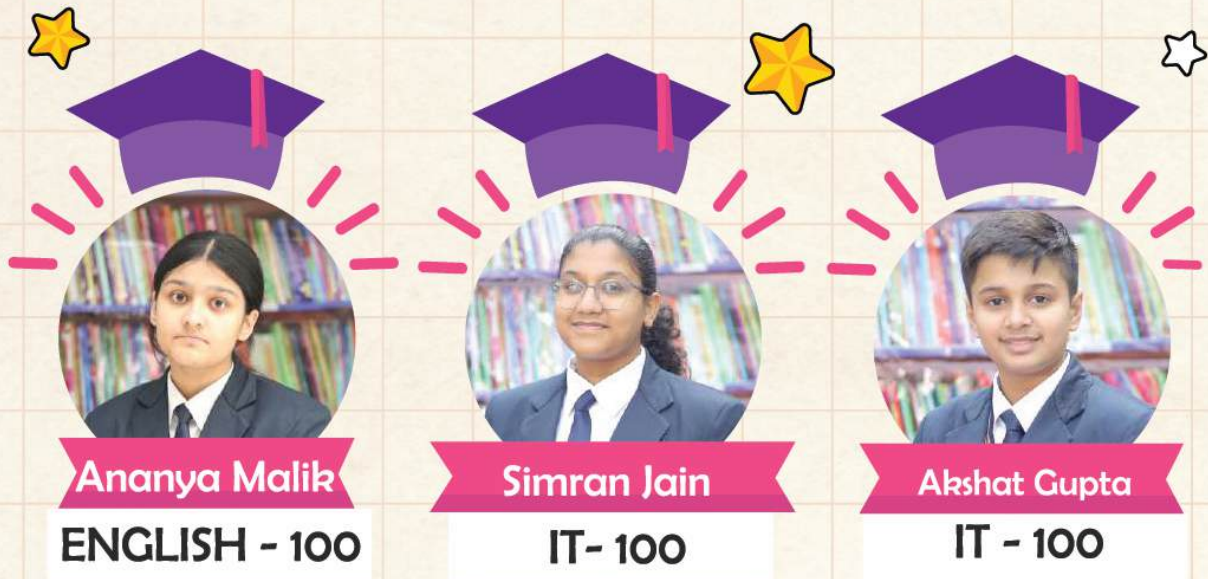

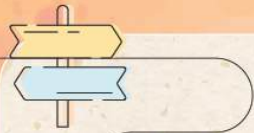


Summer Tide 2026

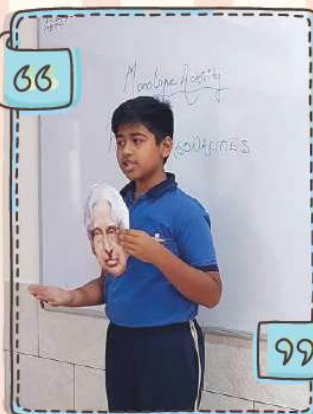
Spark Saturdays

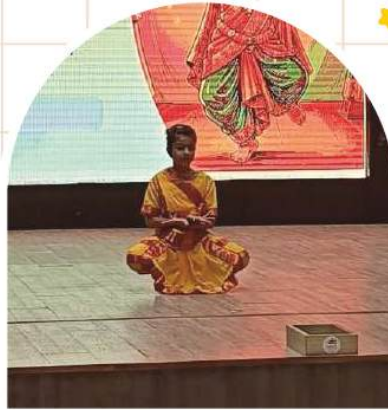
Kaushal Bodh

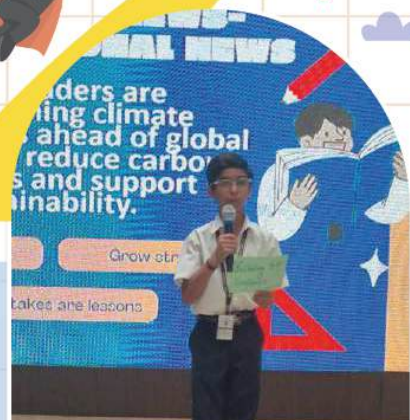

Carefully counting and placing each bindi on the correct rod, they strengthened number sense, one-to-one correspondence, counting accuracy and fine motor coordination through an engaging hands-on mathematical experience.
